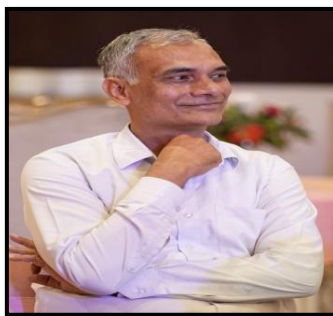

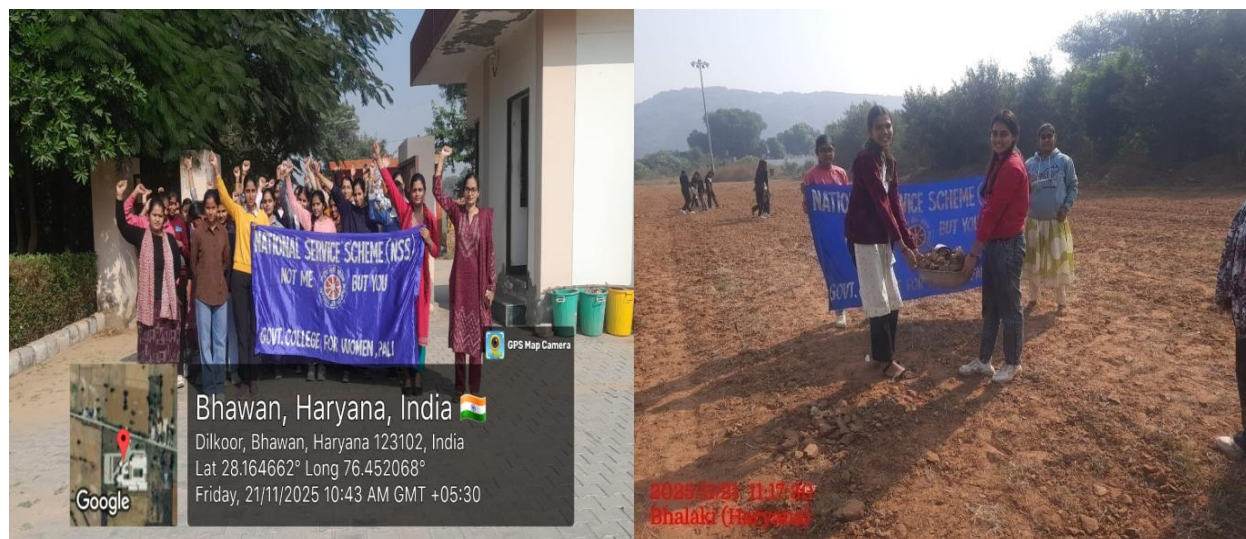

Library

Features of College Library:

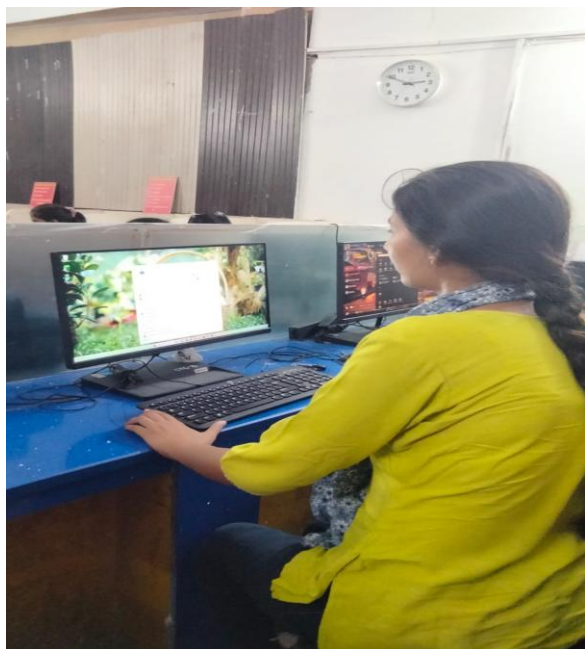

Internships

Under the NEP 2020 framework, undergraduate students are required to complete 60 to 120 hours (4-6 weeks) of mandatory internship to gain practical skills and industry exposure. Students can source their own placements at government organizations private businesses, or NGOs provided they get prior approval from their department. The primary purpose of an internship is to bridge the gap between classroom theory and real-world application. It allows individuals to gain hands-on industry experience, develop professional skills and explore specific career paths before fully committing to them. Beyond practical experience, internships serve several strategic purposes for both the intern and the employer.

During the session 2025-26, 64 students from this college completed their internship. These internships were done in organizations like Bal Bhawan, RESETI of Punjab National bank and skill centers. 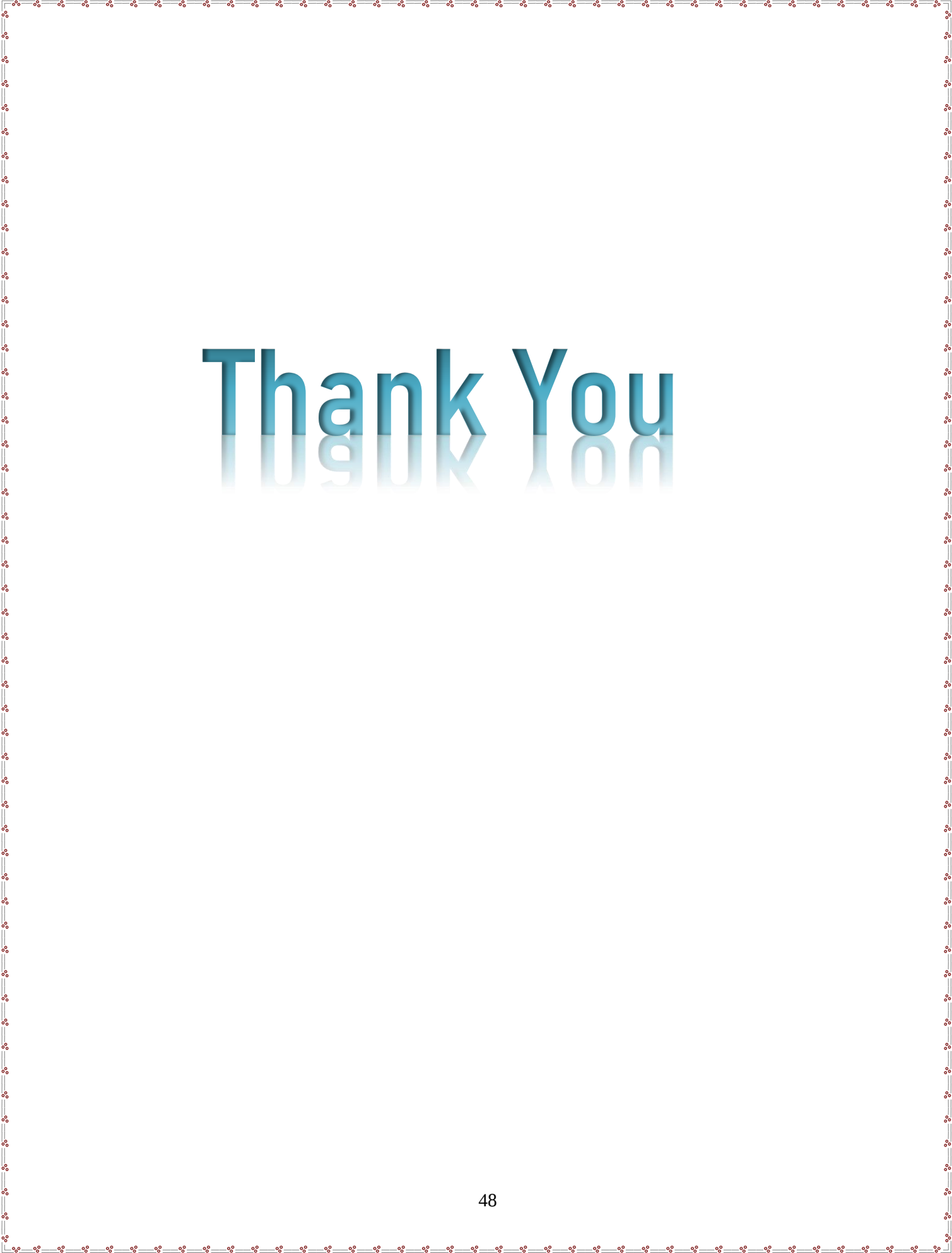
